WHAT REALLY MATTERS



For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision has any value. The only thing that counts is faith expressing itself through love." -Galatians 5:6

Paul found the religious folk getting lost in arguments about things that were totally meaningless to God, and to the real issues of life. Has anything really changed? We still fight about everything from when and where to worship to who should throw out the trash. I believe God is still saying what Paul was trying to tell the Galatians: *"Enough already! Quit arguing about meaningless stuff."* Paul was saying that what matters isn't the things of this world, but faith expressing itself through love. What better place for that to begin than in our marriages. If you don't have faith expressed in love it doesn't matter who throws out the trash, or when and where you worship. These arguments have to do with this temporal life, but faith expressing itself in love is the vehicle that begins in this life to carry us into eternity to be with Jesus and those we love who also know Him. That's what matters! Let's not get lost majoring in the minors. Let's not let the enemy of our marriages, and our souls, distract us from the mission to love with all our hearts and souls and strength. Whenever we sense the enemy trying to tempt us into a meaningless squabble simply ask yourself, "In light of eternity, is this really important?" I guarantee, if you will ask yourself that question regularly you will find an immediate drop in meaningless squabbling. *In light of eternity, is it really important?* What matters is faith expressing itself through love. Try it. It works!
