A Marriage Minute To Help Your Marriage be just a little better today!

AN EMPTY NEST

"And this is my covenant with them says the Lord, 'My spirit will not leave them, and neither will these words I have given you. They will be on your lips and on the lips of your children and your children's children forever, I, the Lord, have spoken!'" --Isaiah 59:21

It is a difficult time when a child leaves home. Some of us are already experiencing "The Empty Nest Syndrome" The real tragedy is that if we haven't been working on our marriage all along that nest will be filled with total emptiness when the children are gone.

If we've taken the time to train them up in the way they should go, they won't depart from it. Now, just what that particular journey looks like is different for each individual. Only God knows the way each one should go. The one thing we can count on is God's promise to spread his wings over our children to keep them in the safety of His presence.

<u>Questions for both of us:</u> How are we training our children? Are we the example that shows the children that God, and submission to His Word must be first? Do they see Christ in us? Why, why not?
